



With GotSport being confirmed down for this weekend, here is how we will proceed with matches. Please pay particular attention to the sections regarding if a team does or does not have access to their player cards. While it is important to maintain the integrity of the league, we will not stop kids from playing soccer because of a technological outage. Once the system is back online, we will be checking and vetting the game cards to ensure no ineligible players participated.

- If you/your managers have a backup roster or State Association roster that you can access, please use that as the game card.
 - Please make sure to write your game information on the top of whatever document you use for your roster this weekend (see attached schedule for game information)
 - If you have additional club pass players you want to add, you can manually write those in, and you will be expected to add them to your roster when GotSport is back online.
 - **Please send me the names and Date of Birth of any club pass players who are not on your roster before your game.**
- If you do not have a backup roster, please print out a picture of an old match card (can be a completed one from a different game) and use that as your roster.
- If you do not have either of the above available, please fill out the attached blank game card.
 - Print it out and use it at the field
 - Also send me (mdellaria@usyouthsoccer.org) a completed copy of the game card
- If your team has access to your player cards, you will use those at the field to check in as normal
- If your team does not have access to your player cards, the referee will use the document provided at check-in and will ask the kids to verify their birth date and name when checking in.
- Turn your rosters/game cards into the referee before the match and write the game information at the top of those documents. The referees will use those two documents

(one from each team) as the game cards. The referees will record scores and discipline on them, and that is what you should take a picture of and submit online as the score once the system is back online.

- Please make sure to take a picture of the game card and record the score/discipline
