REGULAR SEASON LEAGUE FORMAT



YOUNGER AGE GROUPS

For the 13U and 14U age groups, the Elite 64 league season will offer games in a league format that can be scheduled and managed by the clubs over a full 10-month period, as players of this age are generally unaffected by high school soccer.

OLDER AGE GROUPS

For the 15U, 16U, 17U and 18/19U age groups, the Elite 64 league season will offer games in a league format over a 10-month period. The schedule will be created and managed by the clubs to aid players' periodization and involvement in high school soccer.

SCHEDULING OPTIONS

Multiple scheduling options are available to accommodate travel concerns and allow for clubs to complete their league season in the most sensible way possible.

- Home/Away Each club hosts the other clubs in its group one time and travels to each of the opposing clubs in its group one time.
- **Event-based** Multiple clubs come together in a single city and/or venue to compete against two or more other clubs from within their group.
- **Hybrid** Clubs fulfill their matchups with select opposing clubs in a home/away format, while facing other clubs in an event-based format.



NATIONAL EVENTS FORMAT



Elite 64 teams compete in one of two Elite 64 Playoff events. Placement into pools at the Elite 64 Playoffs is based on each team's performance in league play during the previous seasonal year. Results at the Elite 64 Playoffs determine advancement and seeding for the second national event of the season: National League P.R.O.

CURRENT

PREVIOUS



- Teams compete to advance to the USYS National Championships
- Champions Pool teams have the highest probability of advancing to National League P.R.O., followed by Silver and then Wildcard.
- Teams play in a win-and-advance, knockout style bracket.
- All teams play at least three games at the Elite 64 Playoffs
- In each age group, nine teams from each Elite 64 Playoff event (18 total) advance to National League P.R.O.
- Previous season's performance in regular season league play (and Elite 64 Playoffs) determines the pool each team advances to for the next season's Elite 64 Playoffs.

NATIONAL EVENTS LOGISTICS



All national events are stay-and-play. On Location | Anthony Travel is the Exclusive Travel Provider for US Youth Soccer National League and Elite 64 Events. All players, coaches, and team representatives for participating teams, traveling from outside of 100 miles from the tournament location, are required to book their hotel accommodations through the travel provider, into the tournament approved hotels.

DAYS OF PLAY

- Teams will play **at least** three games over three days at national events (one game per day).
- At the **Elite 64 Playoffs**, the Wildcard Pool may require two teams to play a fourth game to determine the team that advances to the next event.
- At **National League P.R.O.**, teams in the Champion Pool and the Wildcard Pool may have a fourth game to determine the team that advances to the USYS National Championships.

ELITE 64 **REGISTRATION**



Elite 64 clubs register via bulk enrollment. This year, clubs have two options to register their players and coaches:

- 1. Direct Registration to USYS Elite 64 This process contains similarly registration processes and requirements as last seasonal year.
- 2. NEW FOR 2023-24 USYS State Passes may be utilized as a form of player/coach registration compliance (i.e. register with your state, those passes are valid and eligible for Elite 64 competition).

During team registration, clubs must designate whether they're registering their players/coaches directly with Elite 64 or choosing to register their players/coaches utilizing their USYS State Association passes.

Player and Team Official Registration (i.e. Roster Building) opened on August 1, and details and instructions were sent out to club leaders.
