COMPLEX INFORMATION

What you need to know about the SoCal Soccer complex:

- Parking is \$15 per Day (Cash/Card)
- No Pets Allowed
- One entrance in/one entrance out (please allow additional time to get through the parking lot booths)
- · Team benches are provided, there is no spectator seating provided.
- There are restrooms and porta potties located to the right of the main entrance.
- · Lost and found will be located at the event headquarters.
- Event Apparel (brought to you by Team IP) will be located at the entrance to the left as you enter the welcome tunnel.
- In the event of severe weather, air horns will sound, and all players/coaches/spectators will be asked to return to their cars. When we have all clear, air horns will be set off again with 3 long shots. NL staff will also communicate via GotSport emails to all teams with all clear.

EVENT RULES & FORMAT

Please ensure you read the <u>rules and procedures</u> before the event. We have a unique bracket format for NL P.R.O., with most games requiring a winner, it is the coach's responsibility to know the rules.

Brackets are set based on seeding. We have avoided in-season division opponents on day 1, but any advancement through the bracket may result in day 2/3 opponents being from your own regular season. This will all depend on results from the previous day.

EVENT REMINDERS

- All official game cards will be printed by the NL staff and be at the fields for check in (teams should have their physical or digital player/coaches passes)
- All games will be recorded by Upper90 using Veo cameras. Video footage will be available on the event home page (under Video Services) approximately one week post event. Teams can bring their own cameras, but you must provide the weights and cameras must be on the spectator side.
- Anthony Travel is the official travel partner of US Youth Soccer. This is a stay and play event.

TEAM CHECKLIST

- All teams must check in (1 team representative) at least 90 minutes prior to your teams first match.
- Team check-in will be located at the end of the tunnel entrance to the left. National League staff
 will be there to check in the team. You will need to bring a copy of the event roster with you. We
 will bring up the team's roster and will have you verify everything is correct. You will also receive
 the teams souvenir bag bags at check in.
- Please note that only 4 coaches/managers will appear on the match card, so if you have more than 4, we will need to remove any coaches/managers NOT attending the event. This only affects the EVENT roster, not you state/league roster.
- To print your EVENT roster as a coach/manager, you can follow these directions.
- To print your EVENT roster as an administrator, you can follow these directions.
