FORMAT AND SCHEDULING

WHO COMPETES?

The National League Mid South Conference has both a Premier I and Premier II Division that includes play for top teamsthroughout Tennessee, Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana, and Arkansas.

WHAT IS THE FORMAT?

For National League Mid South Premier I and Premier II, brackets of up to eight (8) teams will see teams play seven (7) games throughout the course of the season, with mostgames hosted at neutral site events across theregion.

National League games not hosted at Conference events will be self scheduled by teams.

WHEN ARE THE GAMES?

As the National League Mid South Conference encompasses a variety of states, the Conference schedule is fluid based on the teams in each division, with an emphasis to avoid High School conflicts. 14U-19U Boys Premier I and Premier II teams will play a mostly fall based season. 14U-19U Premier I and Premier II girls teams could play entirely in the fall, entirely in the spring, or a combination of both. For 13U Boys and Girls, a Premier II season will be offered in the fall, with Premier I being offered in the spring.

WHY THE NATIONAL LEAGUE MID SOUTH?

The National League Mid South Conference provides a regional-level experience for teams in a competitive and structured environment. It also gives Premier I teams an opportunity to earn their place in a same seasonal year postseason event as well as a National League Quarterfinal event for the next seasonal year. Premier II teams will have the opportunity to automatically qualify for Mid South Premier I for the next seasonal year.

HOW IS IT MANAGED?

The USYS National League manages the Mid South Conference with a full time League Manager and Assistant League Manager

WHAT IS THE COST?

TheMid South Premier I Conferenceis\$925per seasonwhile the Mid South Premier II is \$700 per season. This covers the allMid South Conference events, league management, etc. Referee feesare not included in this fee.

YOUR TEAM'S PATH TO NATIONAL LEAGUE MID SOUTH

EARN YOUR SPOT THROUGH A QUALIFYING LEAGUE

The highest finishing team from Mid South Premier II will automatically qualify for Mid South Premier I the next seasonal year. This is the only league that offers direct qualification into Mid South Premier I.

EARN YOUR SPOT THROUGHMID SOUTH CONFERENCE PERFORMANCE

The top two teams in each National League Mid South Premier I Conference Division will be retained in the Conference for the next seasonal year.

EARN YOUR SPOT THROUGH AN OPEN APPLICATION

Teams that fall outside of the top two pathways can apply for the National League Mid South Conference through completing an Open Application. This pathway allows National League Mid South to get the most competitive teams into the Conference



MID SOUTH TEAM BASED LEAGUE

1st place team plus wildcards qualify for the National League Quarterfinals the next seasonal year

NL QUARTERFINALS

Ten groups of 4. Top 3 teams per group advance to the National League Semifinals. Finish at quarterfinals determines seeding at semifinals.

NL SEMIFINALS

The best teams from the quarterfinal round come together to compete for spots in the USYS National Championships.

NATIONAL LEAGUE'S PATH TO THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

CLUB BASED AND TEAM BASED LEAGUES

The highest finishing team in each National League Mid South Premier I division can qualify for the following season's National League Quarterfinals. Teams may also apply for a wild card slot through an Application process

NATIONAL LEAGUE QUARTERFINALS

The 40 best teams in each age group are placed into 10 groups of four. After three days of group play, the top three teams in each group will advance to the National League Semifinals. The higher a team finishes in its quarterfinal group, the higher the pool placement for the semifinals.

NATIONAL LEAGUE SEMIFINALS



LEAGUE PATHWAY TO THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS


2023-2024 LEAGUE PLAY

CLUB-BASED QUALIFICATION



Eligible teams from a club can play at the quarterfinals, with each team's division finish determining pool placement in the quarterfinals. This applies to Elite 64 divisions.

TEAM-BASED QUALIFICATION



Qualification for the quarterfinals is dependent on the team's finish within its division. This applies to Premier 1 divisions and may include E64 RL and Premier 2 divisions.
